Learn from the pros at the Central Oregon Sportsmen's Show's seminar series. This year's seminars emphasize local fishing and hunting opportunity. Gary Madison's "Advanced Techniques For Calling Predators" on Saturday at 11AM was standing-room-only last year and will probably be again this year. It's a masterclass on the subject by one of the very best. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) plays a much bigger role in this year's show hosting several seminars including one on CWD for hunters on Friday at 4PM. CWD poses an enormous threat to big game populations and Oregon is the outlier without a single case reported thanks to consistently high rates of volunteer compliance in harvested animals checked. Find out more in this informative and important seminar. District biologist Jerry George takes on local trout while Benji Ramirez tackles Ana Reservoir Wipers...little known and discussed and fun to catch. ODFW upland game bird coordinator, Mikal Cline, discusses Ochocco and Blue Mountain fall turkey hunting — she knows where the birds are. Pro guide, Alex Sackerson of Predawn Adventures is back to share detailed perspectives and strategies for Central Oregon waterfowling. Tyler Brown of Little Captain's Tackle talks Central Oregon kokanee on Saturday. Pro guide Marc Bush of Twisted Waters Guide Service takes on two seminars, one on walleye and the other on getting started fishing, "Intro To Fishing". Local outfitter and host of Extreme Desire TV, Candy Yow, shares her expertise in DIY and public lands hunts. For seminar times and topics check out the entire seminar schedule at TheSportShows.com
